Innovation Fund Advantages

- Competition Race-to-the-top sparks innovation
- Sustainability Grants stimulate new + sustainable institutional partnerships
- Scale Since 2014, public/private sector collaboration has generated \$10.5 million to support the Innovation Fund. As of March 2019, a total of 198 grants have been awarded to 370+ teams of HEIs in 25 countries and 42 U.S. states
- Return on Investment Average match of \$1.8 for each donor / partner dollar contributed to Innovation Fund
- Proven Impact On average, one student has access to new international training opportunity for every \$1,300 invested www.100kStrongAmericas.org





Benefits for Higher Education Institutions (HEIs)

- Receive Funding: Teams of HEIs compete for Innovation Fund grants to implement exchange programs to provide more students with access to training opportunities that improve technical + linguistic + cross-cultural skills critical for today's workforce.
- Create Partnerships: Grants support new or existing HEI partnerships to work together to increase short-term dynamic student exchange and training programs in the Americas
- Maximize Visibility: HEIs collaborate with U.S. Department of State, Embassies, NGOs, companies, foundations, academic networks to stimulate regional education cooperation
- Increase Capacity and Access: Provide teams of HEI with new opportunities to implement new programs in multiple academic disciplines to gain knowledge, training, skills
